#### 【Elementary Japanese Language Course】 \*Registration required

Participants will be studying with a Japanese language teacher.

Target : Individuals who are studying Japanese for the first time or wish to start learning from Hiragana and Katakana.

Dates : April 9<sup>th</sup> (Tue) ~July 18<sup>th</sup> (Thu)

Every Tuesday and Thursday, total of 25 sessions

\*We will also hold classes between September and December.

Time : 10:10 am~12:00 pm

Location : CARINO Miyazaki, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor

Course fee : FREE

Textbook : 2,160 yen excluding tax. \*Payable by the Participant

#### 【Japanese Practice Sessions】 \*FREE

Practice daily conversation one-on-one with Japanese-speaking volunteers.

Participants can ask the volunteers to help them practice whatever they want.

Dates: Every Wednesday and Friday

\*No class on national holidays and the New Year's Holiday (Dec 29<sup>th</sup> to Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>)

Time : 10:30 am~11:30 am

Location : CARINO Miyazaki, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor

To apply: Just turn up on the day you wish to take part – although it makes things smoother if you contact us before the first time you plan to go.
