Location: Carino Miyazaki, First basement floor. From Miyazaki Station, walk ten minutes toward the city center. Located next to the Miyazaki Central Post Office.

Hours: 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Tuesday to Saturday)

Closed Sundays, Mondays, public holidays, and during the New Year holidays (December 29<sup>th</sup> to January 3<sup>rd</sup>)

\*If you are coming by car please make use of the Carino parking lot or the nearby paid parking lot. Beware that we do not issue parking vouchers.

# ◆Provision of Information

We help you resolve problems or answer questions that you may have concerning your life in Miyazaki, such as studying Japanese or sightseeing in Miyazaki.



Browse or check out books, magazines, and newspapers

We lend out various books, such as books in foreign languages or Japanese textbooks.

Anyone may checkout library materials for free for up to two weeks (up to two books per person). There are also English newspapers for reading.
