Every year, the Miyazaki International Foundation exhibits works of art by people from overseas living in the prefecture, on the theme of "Miyazaki." Submissions are accepted in four categories: Photography, Paintings, Calligraphy, and Handicraft. This year, the 21st outing for the festival, saw a great number of entries. Each submission is accompanied by comments from the artist themselves on the thoughts behind the piece, and every year, we always hear wonderful comments from visitors to the exhibition about how the artists' feelings and love for Miyazaki come through in the artwork.
